Administrator Report:

Cleaning of sewer lines is continuing.

Maps and Inspection reports are being developed for Sewer lines with dates of cleaning. Flushing of the Water systems will be done this week.

Stainless steel covers were made in house for the Valley at reduced cost than having them purchased.

Meter change outs to the new remote read system have been completed in Skyline. Skyline system is losing water rapidly at a rate of 30%.

Sewer backup insurance claims have been settled with 2 of the 3 residents. Sidel is still expected to review her claim with the Insurance. Confined space upgrades for Sewer are being completed.
