## National Voter Registration Day September 22<sup>nd</sup>

Do you have questions about Absentee Voting? Do you need to update your voter registration or check to make sure you're registered? Do you want to apply for an Absentee Ballot, but are not comfortable going online? Tuesday, September 22nd is YOUR day. Come down to Town Hall between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and we will have resources available to help you! Please be aware that we will encourage social distancing and masks being worn. ## 2020 General Election- NOVEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup>

**Registering to Vote:** Visit [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) and register to vote today! If you are not comfortable going online, we also have forms that you can pick up from the Town Hall. You will need a valid ID and a document that proves your address. If you have questions, please call 608-788-1032 ext. 7. This can be done online until 20 days before the election. **You must be 18 years old, an American Citizen, and a resident of Shelby for at least 28 days. You also must not be currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction (i.e., parole/supervision).** As of October 14th, you will have to register to vote in person at the Clerk's Office or you can register on Election Day.



**Absentee Ballots:** If you would like to receive a ballot in the mail for the November 2020 Election, you can visit [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) and request an absentee ballot OR you can get a request form from Town Hall. You will need your Wisconsin Driver's License or ID card to complete the request. If you have questions, please call 608-788-1032 ext. 7. You can request a ballot be mailed until October 29th at 5:00 p.m. Please plan for mailing timeframes. Ballots must be returned to Town Hall by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

**In-Person Absentee Voting:** In-person absentee voting will take place at the Town Hall from October 19th- 30th between the hours of 8:00-4:00 p.m. per current Wisconsin law. We would like to make sure we can keep you safe while you vote in person. We will be limiting the amount of people in town hall at one time. When you show up, we will get you in, but there might be a short wait while we sanitize between voters. Please call and make an appointment, so we know how many voters to expect and when to expect them. In these uncertain times, we want to make sure you can vote safely and conveniently. Thank you in advance for your patience.



## FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Shelby Fire Department provides fire protection and first responder services, fire safety inspection and education to an area that includes the Town of Shelby, the western part of the Town of Greenfield including St. Joseph Ridge, and the southern part of the Town of Medary accessed from County Road F. The Department has approximately 40 volunteer firefighters and first responders that take calls 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to keep our community safe. In addition to all they do for us, they also assist other communities when they need it. Keep an eye out for fundraisers and events that are held to help support our hometown heroes!

**BURN PERMITS:** Apply ON-LINE! Burning Permits to burn brush or clean, unpainted or untreated wood, must be applied for and approved each time you burn. Burning trash, clothing, tires, railroad ties, etc is illegal.

**FIRE RING PERMITS:** Apply ON-LINE! Fire Ring Permits no longer have to be renewed annually. Beginning with your 2014 permit, it will remain in effect unless you move the fire ring to a new location or you sell your home. In those cases, a new application must be completed and a permit approved by the Shelby Fire Chief.

## BRUSH CHIPPING

As you all know, we have a lot of projects happening in Shelby this year. Our crew works tirelessly to try and get these projects done in a timely manner. To increase efficiency brush chipping will be on the following dates: September 23-24, October 21-22, and November 18-20. Tree limbs may be any length but are limited to 8 inches or less in diameter and should be piled loosely and spread out by the roadside, cut ends toward the street. **Only ONE pick-up load PER residence. Brush piles are limited in size to 4'X4'X8'.** While we encourage being neighborly, we ask that neighbors do not combine piles. They get too big and the crew will tag it and not pick it up. If you have additional brush, you can either take it to the La Crosse County Landfill, apply for a burn permit on our website or hire a tree service.



## REFUSE AND RECYCLING

Below is the Refuse and Recycling calendar. Please note all calendar items for Holidays, Refuse and Recycling Pick up Schedules and Large Item Drop-Off. Also note that the brush pick up schedule was changed over the summer and there are only three pickups left. To get on the list, call 608-788-1032 ext. 6 the TUESDAY before brush pickup. If you call Wednesday morning or afternoon, you will have to wait until the next pick up.

## POLICE NEWS

### Unlawful Dumping

We have had a lot of problems with individuals dumping their garbage into town dumpsters, parks, and the side of Shelby roads. We encourage our residents to properly dispose of their refuse, recycling, yard trimmings, etc. using the proper channels. We will be issuing fines to individuals caught on camera or caught by Town Employees of \$200.00 for unlawful dumping. Unfortunately, due to the number of times this has happened, no more warnings will be issued. Please respect the community we all love and share.



### Noxious Weeds Ordinance

The Shelby Police Department would like to remind all the residents in Shelby that lawn grasses and weeds should be maintained to a height of eight inches or less in length. ## DRIVEWAY PERMITS

Driveway permits are **FREE & REQUIRED** for reconstruction or resurfacing of existing driveways. It allows the Town an opportunity to review drainage at the property and to determine if the driveway culvert needs to be replaced. These permits are available at the Town Hall and are **FREE** of charge. Do not replace a culvert under the driveway or replace concrete or asphalt on your driveway until you have been issued a permit. Allow at least **3 working days** for processing before a permit is issued **BEFORE** you start your driveway project. **Please do not start your driveway project before the permit is issued.** The Town will be enforcing the Town Ordinance 2.08 for any resident who violates this policy and may be subject to penalties.

## EXCAVATION / RIGHT OF WAY/ DUMPSTER PERMITS

Excavation/ Right of Way/ Dumpster Permits are required before placing any structure (i.e., a dumpster) in the road right of way. No obstructions are to be placed in the Town road right of way without a permit. This applies to trees and shrubs, lawn watering systems, mailbox posts (other than standard wooden posts) or any other structures that could be damaged or destroyed by plow trucks or utility installments. Permits are available at the Town Hall.
