LIMITING OFF SALES OF CLASS B INTOXICATING LIQUOR ORDINANCE

Section I. <u>Title/Purpose.</u> This Ordinance is entitled "Limiting Off Sales of Class B Intoxicating Liquor" by providing for election to come under provisions of Section 125.51(3)(b) Intoxicating Liquor of 2007-2008 Wisconsin Statutes." The purpose of the Ordinance is as follows:

To promote the safety, health and general welfare by regulating Class B Liquor sales in the Town of Shelby.

Section II. Retail liquor licenses. "Class B" liquor licenses issued in the Town of Shelby shall permit their holders to sell intoxicating liquors consumed by the glass on premises where sold, and also authorizes the sale of intoxicants contained in the original package. or contained in quantities of not more than four (4) liters at anyone time, and to be consumed off the premises so licensed, except that wine may be sold in the original package or otherwise, in any quantity, to be consumed off the premises.

Section III. Enforcement and Penalties. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section IV. <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable, and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether one or more provisions may be declared invalid, and if any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section V. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication. The provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail over any precious ordinances of the Town of Shelby that are or may be in conflict there with.
