- 1. Call to Order at 4:34 p.m. by Chairperson Kurt Knutson.
- 2. <u>PSC Cost of Service Study and Water Rate Design.</u> Brian Roemer from the Public Service Commission (PSC) gave overview of PSC involvement and steps taken to complete their study and rate design. Mr. Roemer shared the WI Water Rates Dashboard which will be on the website for residents to see their future bill estimates. Discussion on past and future eligibility for different rate options.

- 8. <u>Administrator Report</u>. Peterson gave overview of the updates coming to the website from regarding the PSC rate study and rate comparisons. PSC Public Hearing Notice went out, giving the residents the ability to respond.
- 9. Public Works Report. Terry Wright explained that in home inspections are going well. One concern is that not everyone receiving the letter is calling. A lot of people will be on a secondary list that will have to be contacted once more to set up an inspection. Bids are out for the sewer lining project; the project will get fully underway as soon as possible. Wellhouse #1 and #2 updates. Hopefully Wellhouse #2 will be up and running in May. Dan Odeen and Terry Wright will be going to a training in March. Diamond mapping system will support all the information we are collecting. Update on how much the wells are pumping- reports sent to the DNR.
