- 1. Call to Order at 4:34 p.m. by Chairperson Kurt Knutson.
- 2. <u>Minutes.</u> Motion by Lundsten to approve minutes from 3/11/2021, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. <u>Bills Payable.</u> Motion by Knutson to approve bills \$17,858.12 open invoices, second by Lundsten. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Citizens' Concerns. None.
- 5. Olympic Builders Change Order Request Wellhouse #1 A/C. Change order presented options to add air conditioning to controls room addition for Wellhouse #1. The cost for the contractor to install mini-split or a window unity was not acceptable, and Terry explained he could contract separately for the electrical work and have his crew install a window unit. Motion by Knutson to deny change order and install have town crew install window unit, second by Lundsten. Motion carried unanimously.
- 6. <u>Easement from Town for Arbor Hills Well #1 Parcel.</u> Motion to accept easement from Town for Well #1 Parcel, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously. Direction was given to staff to pursue easements for other district facilities.
- 7. Sewer Lining Project 2021 Phase 1 Award Contract Terry presented the single bid for Sewer Lining in the amount of \$118,161. Motion by Lundsten to award bid to Visu Sewer in the amount of \$118,161, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
- 8. <u>2021 Budget Water and Sewer Peterson presented water and sewer budgets.</u> Motion by Knutson to approve 2021 water and sewer budgets, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
- 9. <u>Administrator Report</u>. Peterson reminded Commissioners of upcoming annual Town Meeting. She noted that Becher Hoppe is working on further analysis of water extension from Boma Road to Ridge. She also gave a report on the first information that was available for the upcoming American Rescue Plan Act funding.
- 10. <u>Public Works Report</u>. Terry Wright gave an update on the Arbor Hills Well project and indicated they are working with SEH to resolve a difference in opinion on the planned chemical feed pumps. Terry has requested the pumps by a variable speed pump so dosages are proportional. Terry is televising more sewer for phase 2 of the sewer lining project.

- 12. Motion by Knutson to adjourn 5:39 p.m., second by Lundsten. Motion carried unanimously.
