- 1. Call to Order at 4:35 p.m. by Chairperson Kurt Knutson.
- 2. <u>Review and Approve Minutes from 4/22/2021.</u> Motion by Knutson to approve minutes, second by Lundsten. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. <u>Review and Approve Bills Payable.</u> Motion by Lundsten to approve \$2,123.83 in open invoices and \$19.592.88 paid, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. <u>Citizens' Concerns.</u> None.
- 5. <u>Arbor Hills Well Project Olympic Pay Estimate #12.</u> Estimate had not been submitted, so will be placed on the next meeting agenda.
- 6. <u>Well Protection Plan.</u> Randy Sanford gave an overview of the draft plan developed by Rural Water. He noted that the District may need to enact ordinance to meet the requirements of the plan.
- 7. State of Wisconsin Safe Driving Water Loan Program WI Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Department of Administration (DOA), and Shelby Sanitary District No.2. \$714,964.00 Financial Assistance Agreement Dated as of May 26, 2021. Motion by Ehler to approve Financial Assistance Agreement, second by Lundsten. Motion carried unanimously.
- 8. Resolution 2021-2 Authorizing the Issuance and Sale of up to \$714,964.00 General Obligation Water System Promissory Notes, Series 2021, and Providing for Other Details and Covenants with Respect Thereto. Motion by Lundsten to approve Resolution 2021-2, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
- 9. <u>Administrator Report</u>. Peterson gave an update on the Federal Rescue Act and noted it could be used for water and sewer, including testing of private wells.
- 10. <u>Public Works Report</u>. Wright gave update on recent repair to Arbor Hills Well #1 Reservoir and a summary of a sewer backup issue for a resident on Stonecrest. He also noted that the water meter reader will be replaced at a cost of approximately \$16,000.
- 11. <u>Chairperson/Commissioner Report(s).</u> Knutson asked for an update regarding Woodhaven private shared well project.
- 12. Motion to adjourn 5:25 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
