- 1. Meeting called to order by Candahl at 5:04 p.m.
- 2. <u>Approve Minutes from 8/4/2020.</u> Motion by Heal, second by Knutson. Motion passed unanimously.
- 3. <u>Payment of Bills.</u> Motion by Padesky to pay Open Invoices: \$68,713.36, second by Knutson. Motion carried unanimously.

- 5. <u>Bluffland Coalition-Coordination of Projects.</u> Administrator discussed letter that was sent to residents regarding a project the Coalition would like to get done. We will work closely with them to make sure we are on the same page. The plan is still a work in progress, but we will request that they do not move forward with contacting residents until we are all in agreement with the plan.
